

Windsor-Toronto-Montreal (WTM) Airspace and Services Review

Class F Airspace Changes in Southern Ontario

NAV CANADA, the country's provider of civil air navigation services, has completed an Aeronautical Study of Southern Ontario Class F Airspace as part of the WTM Airspace and Services Review. The recommendations from this study will result in the following airspace changes and revisions to the Designated Airspace Handbook (DAH).

CYR 535 CAYUGA To 11,000 Ocsl by NOTAM	Remove from DAH
CYA512 (P) SIMCOE To 7,500' ocsl higher by NOTAM; Cont daylight Wed, Sat Sun and Hols. O/T by NOTAM	Remove from DAH
CYA 509 (P) COOKSTOWN To 4,500 Ocsl higher by NOTAM Ocsl daylight by NOTAM	Retain CYA. Remove "Ocsl higher by NOTAM". Add caution box on charts to read "CAUTION: PARADROPS FROM 14,000 ASL"
CYA 515 (P) COLDWATER To 12,500' Ocsl daylight by NOTAM	Remove from DAH
CYA 516 (P) GANANOQUE To 12,500 Cont Daylight	Retain CYA. Change text to: "Daylight Apr to Oct, Fri, Sat, Sun & hols. O/T by NOTAM". Add caution box on charts to read "CAUTION: PARADROPS FROM 14,000 ASL"
CYA 517 (P) ARTHUR NORTH To 12,500 Ocsl daylight by NOTAM	Not listed in the DAH. Remove from Toronto VTA and VNC charts.
CYA 520 (T) PORT PERRY To 4,000 Cont daylight	Remove from DAH.
CYA 523 (A) MOUNT FOREST To 6000 cont daylight	Remove from DAH.
CYA 532 (A) LAKE SIMCOE To 6,000 Ocsl by NOTAM	Remove from DAH.
CYA 525 (A) CAYUGA To 4,000 cont daylight	Remove from DAH.
CYA 526 (A) SELKIRK To 6,000 cont daylight	Retain CYA. Change text to: "Ocsl daylight by NOTAM"

These changes will take effect March 12, 2009 at 09:01 Coordinated Time Universal Time (UTC). The appropriate aeronautical publications will be amended.
