

# NEW Weather Minimums

## THERE WILL BE NO FLYING AT AND INCLUDING THE STATED TEMPERATURES

### 6.1 Weather minima – Student Training, non licenced / Night rating

• Practice Area	2000 ft AGL/ 3 statute miles	2000 ft AGL/ 5 statute miles
• Circuits	1500 ft AGL/ 3 statute miles	1500 ft AGL/ 3 statute miles
• Cross-country	2000 ft / 4 statute miles	3000 ft / 5 statute miles
• Wind	30 knot wind / 20 knot cross-wind	30 knot wind / 20 knot cross-wind
• Temperature	No flights below -20°C and above 30°C	No flights below -20°C and above 30°C

#### 6.1.1 Day and Night Solo Flights

	<b>Day Solo Flights</b>	<b>Night Solo Flights</b>
• Practice Area	3000 ft AGL/ 6 statute miles	3000 ft AGL/ 10 statute miles
• Circuits	2000 ft AGL/ 4 statute miles	2000 ft AGL/ 5 statute miles
• Cross-country	4000 ft / 10 statute miles	4000 ft / 10 statute miles
• Wind	15 knot wind / 13 knot cross-wind	15 knot wind / 13 knot cross-wind
• Temperature	No flights below -10°C and above 30°C	No flights below -10°C and above 30°C

#### 6.1.2 Solo cross-country flights

Solo cross-country flights are not permitted during the following times:  
Eastern Standard Time after 1200 local  
Daylight Savings Time after 1400 local

The above weather minima for solo cross-country flights must be forecast to remain above the minima for the duration of the cross country, and for one hour thereafter.

### 6.2 Weather Minima – Renters

#### 6.2.1 Gold Currency Rental Pilot Requirements

Toronto Airways Ltd. Rental weather requirements are as per the Company Rental Policy and listed below:

Practice Area:	2000 ft AGL/ 3 miles
Circuits:	1500 ft AGL/ 3 miles
Cross-country:	3000 ft / 6 miles (must be forecast to remain throughout duration of flight)
Wind:	25 knot max. Wind (max 13 knot cross-wind) this applies to all flights
Temperature:	No flights below -20°C and above 30°C

#### 6.2.2 Platinum Currency Rental Pilot Requirements

Toronto Airways Ltd. Rental weather requirements are as per the Company Rental Policy and listed below:

Practice Area:	1500 ft AGL/ 1 mile
Circuits:	1500 ft AGL/ 1 mile
Cross-country:	2000 ft / 3 miles (must be forecast to remain throughout duration of flight)
Wind:	25 knot max. Wind (max 15 knot cross-wind) this applies to all flights
Temperature:	No flights below -20°C and above 30°C

Pilots holding platinum currency may use special VFR to exit the zone and to proceed under cross-country limits to destination

#### 6.2.3 Platinum Currency Rental IFR Requirements

Toronto Airways Ltd. under the discretion of the Chief Flight Instructor will extend to Renters the privilege of filing IFR in instrument conditions. This privilege will be issued on a case-by-case basis depending on experience and qualifications.

All flights to be conducted under Instrument Flight Rules must comply with the CARs weather requirements with regard to approach minimums and alternate requirements. Toronto Airways Ltd. requires for IFR flights higher alternate requirements for alternate weather minima to be forecast for the arrival time +/- 2 hours:

- Take-off limits 700 feet and one statute mile
- Landing limits as published plus 300 feet
- Alternate minima plus 300 feet
- No condition of thunderstorms forecast or reported
- No forecast or reported icing conditions
